Aviation fun for the whole family! Are your eyes drawn to the sky by passing aircraft? Bring the family to experience this gathering of aircraft and aviation enthusiasts at Double Eagle II Airport on Albuquerque's west side. Join the thousands that attend this annual event!

Like a car show, aircraft will fly in to be judged, while spectators stroll the flight line to view antique to modern airplanes, gliders, and helicopters -- up close! Come early to see arriving aircraft and catch the 8am Opening Ceremony!

Expected highlights include an appearance of the "Chile Flight", a local formation flying team of amateur-built Vans RV

aircraft who opened the 2018 Balloon Fiesta, 2019 Kirtland Air Show, and the Isotopes season. See award-winning aircraft recognized at EAA's AirVenture in Oshkosh, WI, and other local amateur-built and restored vintage aircraft. Car fans can enjoy show cars by local Albuquerque Volkswagen and MOPAR Car Clubs.

Opportunities to be immersed in aviation abound in the Exhibit Hall and on the ramp. Attendees can interact with career and recreational pilots, aviation mechanics, weather forecasters, air traffic controllers, engineers, and amateur aircraft builders. One can explore aviation history, career and education options, recreational flying, avionics

technology, and flying remote control aircraft.

Youth of all ages enjoy hands on activities at the Youth Aviators Center, plus riveting, aircraft fabric, and 3-D printing with help from aircraft builders at Builder's Corner.

Open to the public from 7am – 3pm, admission and parking are FREE. Food is \$5.00 for the whole day, which includes a pancake breakfast and a chicken fajita lunch. Kids 12 and younger eat for FREE!

Over 30 exhibitors participate including local avionics businesses such as Aspen Avionics, BendixKing, Sandia Aerospace, AeroVonics, and Air One Systems. Suncountry Cubs will show CubCrafters aircraft.

The public is also invited to free seminars including *Back Country Flying in New Mexico* presented by the New Mexico Pilots Association, *Explore Instrument Flying Scenarios* presented by EAA 179's IMC Club, and *Flying and Building High Performance Experimental Aircraft* presented by EAA Technical Counselor, Will Fox.

According to Chapter 179 President, Emilio Verastegui, "what makes this event possible is that our members share their time and talent to promote general aviation. They truly demonstrate EAA's *spirit of aviation*!" Any
